

3 金城ふ頭 Kinjo Pier

親しまれる交流拠点として開発進む「金城ふ頭」

Kinjo Pier is being developed as an integrated area that will attract many people

各種大型船が接岸する商港機能のほか、船舶情報の集約される情報拠点としても活躍している「金城ふ頭」。近年は、交流拠点としての開発が行われています。

さらに、名古屋市の計画による「モノづくり文化交流拠点」として、鉄道博物館など、産業技術の発信・継承をテーマに、人々が交流する拠点づくりが進行中。人々に親しまれるふ頭としての新たな歴史を歩み始めています。

In addition to commercial port functions that can accommodate various large vessels, Kinjo Pier also functions as an information administration center for the consolidation of vessel information. Kinjo Pier is currently being developed into a public communication exchange area.

On the basis of the Concept "Central Exchange Area for Monozukuri Culture" being planned by Nagoya City, a hub for interaction between people is now being designed under the theme of showing and passing on industrial technology. The concept includes things such as opening a railway museum. The pier is adding new pages in its history as a popular site among visitors.

テーマパーク (レゴランド®・ジャパン・リゾート) Theme Park (LEGOLAND® Japan Resort)

家族で一日楽しめる屋外型キッズテーマパーク「レゴランド®・ジャパン」と「レゴランド®・ジャパン・ホテル」、 「シーライフ名古屋」が併設。

The LEGOLAND® Japan outdoor theme park for kids, where the whole family can enjoy an entire day, the LEGOLAND® Japan Hotel and SEA LIFE Nagoya aquarium are all annexed.



東側には、「モノをつくる喜び」と「コトをつくる喜び」をテーマにした複合型商業施設「メイカーズピア」が隣接。

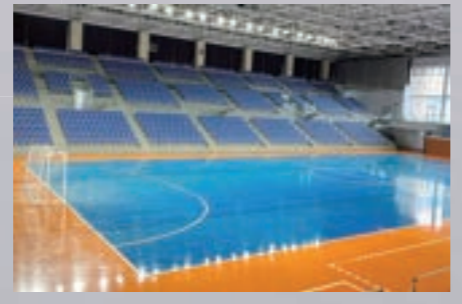
On the adjoining to the land on the east is also the "Maker's Pier," a commercial complex with the theme of "the joy of creating and making events."



スポーツ施設 (名古屋金城ふ頭アリーナ) Sports Facilities (Nagoya Kinjo Pier Arena)

様々なスポーツで利用できます。メインアリーナには約2,500席の観客席を設置。

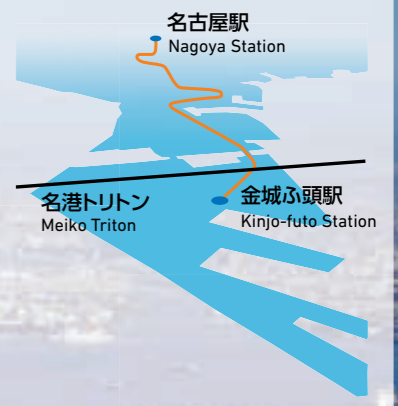
This facility, equipped with 2,500 seats in the main arena, can be used for various sports.



旅客鉄道 (あおなみ線) Aonami Line

名古屋駅から金城ふ頭駅までの15.2kmを約24分で結ぶ旅客鉄道。2004年(平成16年)10月開業。

This passenger line, opened in October 2004, connects Kinjo-futo Station and Nagoya Station, 15.2 km away, in 24 minutes.



鉄道系博物館 (リニア・鉄道館) SCMAGLEV® and Railway Park

東海道新幹線を中心に、在来線から超電導リニアまでの実物車両の展示を通じて「高速鉄道技術の進歩」を紹介している施設。

This museum introduces the progress in high-speed railway through rolling stock displays, which include the superconducting maglev as well as historic railway rolling stock.

名古屋市国際展示場 (ポートメッセなごや) Nagoya International Exhibition Hall (Portmesse Nagoya)

20,000㎡の無柱空間を誇る第1展示館をはじめとした計3つの展示施設及びコンベンションセンター等の集合施設を有する国内有数の展示場。

The largest international exhibition facility in Nagoya City. It opened in 1973 and this year marks its 50th anniversary. Exhibition Hall 1 with an open, pillarless space of 20,000 m² and a Convention Center with two convention halls were opened in October 2022.
